## Class History

In September, 1952, we began our journey as freshmen at BHS by electing as President, Fred Muller; Vice-President, Jane Powers; Secretary, Jere Michaels; and Treasurer, Hilda Schmadtke. Our Student Council representatives were Don Fuller and Doug Bidwell. To guide us along our rocky path we had Mrs. Wilson, Mrs, Hawkins, and Miss Beauchamp as class advisors. These advisors helped us choose our class colors which are still purple and white. Our class flower is a white carnation, and our class motto is "From A Little Spark May Burst A Mighty Flame."

During this hectic year the freshmen and sophomores had a joint class party on December 16. September 19, the sophomores held an Initiation Dance for the freshmen. The Freshman Banquet was held for the parents and students on October 13. The teachers were also invited. There were 83 students in this new class.

To start our sophomore year we set up a system to pay our class dues which was five dollars a year. In this year we chose as our President, Doug Bidwell; Vice-President, Jere Michaels; Secretary, Jane Powers; Treasurer, Sheila Dougherty. The Student Council representatives were Judy Holden and Larry Pearsall. The Sophomore Banquet was held on March 26. In attendance were our class advisors, Mrs. Wilson, Mrs. Monroe, and Mrs. Beckwith.

In our junior year we chose as our officers Colton Park, President; Bob McLean, Vice-President; Rosalyn Nelson, Secretary; and Tom Wilson, Treasurer. The Student Council representatives were Bob Schreer and Jim Eldis. Our advisors were Mrs. Wilson, Mrs. Monroe, and Mr. L. K. Snider. We ordered our rings from Terryberry Co. in October and received them on December 21, 1954. We gave one dance and the J-Hop which was held at Pine Lodge on the 14th of May. The theme was "Neptune's Gardens" and the band was that of Jim Service. The Junior play, "The Skeleton Walks, " was held in March and the Junior Banquet was held in May. Our skip day was one that will remain with the Senior of "56" forever. This wonderful day was spent at Burroughs Farms.

The year of Graduation had finally arrived. We chose Don Fuller, President; Dick Morgan, Vice-President; Janet Lanning, Secretary; and re-elected Tom Wilson as Treasurer. The Student Council representatives were Larry Pearsall and Colton Park. Our first money-making project was handling the concessions at the football and the basketball games. Our biggest money-making project was the magazine sales. During the first week in October, our class had its Senior pictures taken and got them back around the 15 th of December. On the 28 th of December we had our annual winter formal which was called "The Snowflake Whirl." The band was Jim Kenny's Skylarks. The dance was held in the band room. In March we had our annual Senior Banquet. We planned our Senior Trip for the first week in May. The last few days of our high school career were soon upon us. Graduation Day was hours instead of days ahead. Baccalaureate was held on June 3, and in the afternoon of June 6 we held the traditional ceremony of Class Day. As has been the custom for the last few years, our graduation was held in the High School Gym on June 7. The realization that our high school days were at an end was the only sad thought that marred this happy occasion.
