Class History

The autumn of "52" found the class of "57" beginning at the bottom of the ladder of learning as Freshmen. The 85 members of the class chose our class officers. John Boudeman was elected President; Dave Lanning, Vice-President; Ann Frederick, Secretary; Gay Stonex, Treasurer. Jim Wirick and Jim Herrmann were chosen as student council representatives. We also selected the white carnation as the class flower, turquoise and white as the class colors, and "The Way to be Happy is to Make Others Happy" as the class motto. Our class advisors were Mrs. Beckwith and Mr. Edward Smith. We had a class party, and we sponsored a dance after both football and basketball games.

Climbing up another rung, we started our Sophomore year with Martha Andrews, President; Roger Thompson, Vice-President; Gay Stonex, Secretary; Hazel Mc-Gregor, Treasurer; Marilyn Biers and John Boudeman, student council representatives. We decided to change our class motto. "We are Today's Youth-Tomorrow's Hope" was selected. Our class advisors were also changed. They were Mrs. Lobdell and Mr. Martin who continued through the senior year. On December 17, we held a candy sale in the cafeteria to help build up our treasury. We had a dance on January 21 and a class party on April 19. We also made a

field trip to the Henry Ford Museum and Greenfield Village.

It was 1954 and we were ready to start another year in the halls and classrooms of good old Brighton High, this time as Juniors. Our first job was to select our officers. We chose Jim Wirick, President; Pat Flanagan, Vice-President; Patsy Durbin, Secretary; Gay Stonex, Treasurer; Jim Herrmann and Ann Fredericks, student council representatives. Our class had its banquet on February 7. Our play was presented April 12 and 13. It was a drama entitled "Lost Horizon". We

held the J-Hop for the Seniors on May 12.

Our Senior year started in the autumn of "56". Our officers were Bob Quackenbush, President; Roger Thompson, Vice-President; Mary Dee Pullen, Secretary; Pat Flanagan, Treasurer; Patsy Durbin and Frank Southwell, student council representatives. We started our money-making projects with a magazine subscription drive. John Morris sold the most subscriptions to help us reach our goal of \$2500. We had charge of the football and basketball concessions which helped greatly in our financial attempts. On November 15 and 16 we presented our play. It was a light comedy entitled "Boarding House Reach". We received our Senior pictures on November 28. We invited all the underclassmen to attend our Winter Formal. In May we went on our Senior trip. New York was chosen and a fine time was had by all. Baccalaureate was held on Sunday, June 2, class day on June 5, and graduation on June 6. We had finally reached the top of the ladder.
