## Class History

As we started up the Mountain of Learning we were officially initiated by the upperclassmen which made us Freshmen. We elected our class officers at our first class meeting. Jon Pless was elected President; Virgil Ramey Vice-President; Donna Harrison Secretary; 5oAnn Liptak Treasurer; and Bill Loveland and Happy Pullen Student Council Representatives. Mr. Smith and Mrs. Hawkins were our class advisors. We chose the Carnation as our class flower, Blue and White as our class colors and "Today we Follow, Tomorrow we Lead" as our class motto. Football season soon rolled around and we elected Veronica DeRosia as our Freshman Queen Attendant. Our Freshman Banquet was held on March 22, 1955.

We were then one-fourth of the way to the top of our Mountain of Learning. To start the year, we, the class of '58, elected our class officers. We elected Gayle Roberts as our President; Gloria Riley as Vice-President; Lois Churchill as Secretary; Virgil Ramey as Treasurer and Happy Pullen and Lynn Michaels as our Student Council Representatives, Football season rolled around again and our Sophomore Queen Attendant was JoAnn Liptak. We had our Sophomore Banquet on November 10, 1955. Also, during the Fall we wrote our Constitution. To help to get the money for our Senior Trip we had a Bake Sale. This turned out very well. The class decided to have their Sophomore Trip on May 9, 1956. We chartered two Greyhound Buses and journeyed to the Redford Township Police Department, the Detroit Institute of Art and the Detroit Historical Museum. It was a rainy day but fun was had by all.

Now we were half way up the Mountain of Learning. This year we elected Jim McGregor as President; Lawrence Keckonen as Vice-President; Cathy Bosworth as Secretary; Bill Taylor as Treasurer; and Janet Shultz and JoAnn Liptak as our Student Council Representatives. Our Junior Queen Attendant was Janet Shultz. Our Junior Banquet was on February 14, 1957 on Valentines Day with "Ahead to ' 58 " as our theme. Finally we had our long-awaited chance to present a play to the whole community. The play, "Mr. Icebox", was presented on April 11 and 12 of 1957. The J-Hop was our next big event. It was held on May 18, 1957, at the Lakeland Golf and Country Club. Our Theme was "Shangri-la". Our last event of the year was our Junior Skip Day. It was held on May 24, 1957 at Burrough's Farm. Every one enjoyed the day. Anticipating the heavy schedule of work we would encounter in our Senior year, we readied our class machinery for a fast start by holding class elections at this time. We elected Lawrence Keckonen as our President; Virgil Ramey as Vice-President; Janet Shultz as Secretary; Sandra Kelley as Treasurer; Karen Hargesheimer and Betsy Crawford as our Student Council Representatives.

Having elected our class officers at the end of our Junior year, we got right down to business. Our Queen was Cathy Besworth and our Senior Queen Attendant was Karen Hargesheimer. In October we had our Magazine Subscription Drive. We made our goal which was $\$ 3,000$ and went considerably over it. On November 18 and 19, 1957, our Senior Play, "Finders, Creepers", was held in the high school gym. During Football season we had charge of the concessions which helped us raise funds for the Senior Trip. We, also, had charge of the concessions during Basketball season. After our first home Basketball game on December 13, we sponsored a dance. It was a "Sok-Hop". Our Senior Banquet was held in . the Spring. We went to Washingtorr for our Senior Trip. We were gone for 5 days. Everyone who went had a wonderful time. Class Day was held on June 4, 1958. We finally reached the top of our first Mountain of Learning and received our Long- awaited diplomas.
